

PROOF OF LIFE CERTIFICATE

TO ALL ELDERS OF CHIPPEWAS OF THE THAMES FIRST NATION:

This Proof of Life Certificate will be an accepted form of proving to Chippewas of the Thames First Nation that you are alive and, therefore, eligible to continue to receive a monthly Income Stabilization Fund payment.

Beginning January 1, 2014, this Proof of Life Certificate must be completed on an annual basis and received by the Chippewas of the Thames First Nation Trust Administration Manager by the first (1st) of the month of your birthday.

This Proof of Life Certificate shall be completed and signed by an independent witness, 18 years or older, who is not related to you. As per Chippewas of the Thames First Nation's Leadership Manual the definition of a "Related Person" is as follows:

"...means a spouse, parent, parent-in-law, sibling, child, grandchild, dependant, aunt, uncle, niece, nephew, 1st cousin, any person with whom that person currently resides, or a corporation or other organization in which that person has an interest."

Failure to submit the Proof of Life Certificate on time will result in the suspension of your Income Stabilization Fund payment. The monthly payment will be restarted once the Proof of Life Certificate has been received by the Trust Administration Manager. Any suspended payments will **NOT** be paid retroactively.
